social security disability benefits for people living with ... - when applying for ssdi, a patient's medical records should be accompanied by a medical source statement (or mss) in the form of a letter from his or her licensed medical practitioner.

an assessment of consultative examination (ce) processes ... - a consultative examination (ce) is a physical or mental health examination or test purchased on behalf of a claimant at ssa's expense and is requested by the agency to make a disability determination.

documenting disability - national health care for the ... - primary care and mental health/substance abuse services. two basic strategies are recommended to support applications for disability assistance: 1) refer explicitly to medical criteria for disability specified in the ssa's listing of impairments.
